This form of Batard is named **Schwabacker**. Keep these forms very compressed and spiky. The main difference between this variation and Fraktur is the shape of the O. In this variation it is almond shape. C-0 nib, 50° pen angle, body height five nibs (on this page 1 inch), interlinear space 2 1/2 nibs (1/2 inch). Please note various shapes at the top of ascenders.
